





Help us to Reduce Medicines Waste

Last year, wasted medicines cost NHS Fife £2.1 million, which could be used to fund other health services, with 28 tonnes of



unused medicines returned in Fife.







Causes of Avoidable Medicines Waste

- Over-ordering by patients, carers and staff.
- Current medicines being returned inappropriately.
- Patient's own drugs not being used, transferred or sent home.







We can Make a Difference by:

- Checking what medicines we have before ordering more
- Using patient's own medicines when available and safe to do so
- Ensuring medicines are transferred with the patient when they move ward
- Asking if relatives can bring patient's medicines into hospital if they arrive without them







Campaign Messages

- Check Before You Order
- Only Order What You Need
- Check Your Prescriptions Bag
- Bring Your Medicines into Hospital and Remember to Take Them Home
- Talk to the Pharmacy Team in your Local Pharmacy or GP Practice
- Remember that Unused Medicines are a Safety Risk and Cannot be Recycled
